TEA SIGNS LOAN AGREEMENT WORTH 800M/- FOR CONSTRUCTION OF ST. AUGUSTINE TABORA CAMPUS HOSTEL

July 5th 2010 Tanzania Education Authority signed a loan agreement of 800m/- with Saint Augustine University Tabora campus.

The loan is for construction of two hostel wings for female students. The Hostel is expected to accommodate 240 to 300 students. Construction will be done in two phases.

The loan which will be paid in five years time with a 6% interest was signed by TEA Director General Mrs. Rosemary Lulabuka and the Saint Augustine University Vice Chancellor Fr. Charles Kitima in a presence of Bishop for Tabora Diocese Fr. Paulo Ruzoka, Tanzania Episcopal Council Secretary Fr. Anthony Makunde and TEA Corporate Secretary Mr. Joel Laurent.

TEA is proud to be part of this project which aims at increasing access to higher education in Tanzania. This will be the first University to be established in Tabora Region.
