# THE EDUCATION FUND



## 1. About Tanzania Education Authority (TEA)

Tanzania Education Authority (TEA) was established under section 5 (1) of The Education Fund Act No.8 2001 to manage the Education Fund. The Fund was established under the same Act with the intention of supplementing the Government's efforts in financing education development in all levels of education Tanzania mainland and financing tertiary levels of education in Tanzania Zanzibar.

## 2. The Education Fund

Since its establishment in 2001, the Fund has been acting as a pool into which resources collected from Government allocations, voluntary contributions, and grants loans and from "Other Sources" are deposited in order to fund projects geared towards education development to all levels



## 3. Who can contribute to the Education Fund?

Opportunities to support the Education Fund are open to individuals, private and public organization from within the country and abroad. The support may be donated in form of money, materials or services to the Education Fund, or to Fund assisted project in any areas of preference. In addition to financing projects, a contributor can be anybody who avails sponsorship or grants to students other than his own or his own family members or his employer, for purposes of enabling them to pursue education at secondary or tertiary levels. This should be done in coordination with Tanzania Education Authority.

- A contributor as provided in section 12 (1) (a) and (b) of the Education Fund Act, no 8 of 2001 can be Individuals, corporate bodies, public and private institutions, civil societies and faith-based organizations.
- Either any person can make a donation in form of money, goods, or services to the Education Fund or a fund assisted projects



## 4. Advantages of Contributing to the Education Fund

Contributors to the Education Fund shall be entitled to recognition benefits,

- through being awarded a Certificate of Educational Appreciation (CEA) or a Letter of Education Appreciation (LEA) to express gratitude for their philanthropy.

All contributors qualify for certificate of Education Appreciations(CEA) in different colors depending on the value of contributions received as follows;

➤ **Metalic Blue Tsh. 100,000 - 999,999**

➤ **Metalic Silver Tsh. 1,000,000 – 9,999,999**

➤ **Metalic Red Tsh. 10,000,000 – 99,999,999**

➤ **Metallic Gold 100,000,000 and above**

- Tax relief incentives; Section 16 (1) of the Income Tax Act (CAP. 332 R.E 2019) has provision for contributors to the Education Fund to utilize Certificate of Educational Appreciation (CEA) to apply for Tax relief.
- Additionally, contributors who are taxpayers may choose to apply for tax relief.
- Registration of contributors in the Education Fund contributor's database for permanent records.
- Lastly, contributors will also obtain local and internal publicity.
